The Founder and Secretary of this organisation GREEN (in short name of acronym – abbreviation) namely Mr. P.S. Bose – an energetic young male wish to communicate with the society with greater confidence to do the service to the people in need and to promote awareness and action efforts for their wholistic development. He realized the problems faced by the people and wants to should not live in the house of corner; they must have experience to communicate with the other people. Then they should get their rights, thus he started the GREEN.

Our Mission

Form groups of women SHGs, Awareness to Environmental Protection and Biodiversity conservation, Training to enhance the rural youths for self employable and sustained life style, and advocate with CBO’s / Stakeholders to ensure access to Education, Health, Employment and Social inclusion and to promote advocacy to bring about positive change in their lives.

- ❖ Provision of rehabilitation services for differently able person.
- ❖ Providing awareness and leadership training to members of the trust.
- ❖ Any activity that will promote the welfare and rights of the need person.

Our Target Area:

GREEN is working in the admin Blocks like, Chinnamanur, Uthamapalayam, Cumbum, Bodinayackanur and some places including the remote working area, in Theni district. It is working with the population covered about 1, 86,500 spreader over including the 136 villages panchayats are engaged in the activities of our organisation.

WOMEN DEVELOPMENT

❁ Women Empowerment Groups



Women are the vital component of the functioning of the community. They are the pivot of the society. For achieving this we have formed them into following kinds of groups:

- (1) Village level Cleaning Groups
- (2) Village Women Awareness Groups
- (3) Women Leader / PRI development Group

GREEN Society believed this and continuing its service performances on the field of women development and approaching welfare activities centered with women participants. Every year we have organized these groups among the rural women community and make them to use our beneficiaries for their sustainable living.

These groups are collectively involved in the belonging community development initiatives. The Village level Cleaning groups are the responsible to make the village clean and green and the Village Health groups are monitor the health schemes implementation and sanitation, hygienic environment of the village. The Village Leaders Development group will responsible to develop women leadership among the village community.

A Capacity Building Training on promoting self reliant Qualities to these group members was conducted. This training created a platform to the rurally backward women on obtaining their welfare measures. Under this group meeting, the women were discussed the various issues surrounding them and finding solutions to rectify the same through collective efforts and community involvement.

This training facilitates the Women to understand the Group Dynamics, enhancing Leadership Qualities, Organising Events, starting units for income generation, facilitating members for obtaining various services etc., It also provides the information about how to assess the performance activities, loan repayment capacity, involvement of members and local issues and problems. This can educate the members in the accounts and book keeping procedures maintenance of minute's books etc.,



Further this Capacity Building Training facilitated them on understanding the power of realizing the strength of unity. This created the cohesiveness and supports within the women and the women makes their collective efforts for their women community as well as social development.

Micro Entrepreneurs Development (MEDP) Program

In our existing women SHGs many were moving for additional linkages of loans through Banks and other MFIs in this year. We has facilitated them through the Micro Credit Linkages Programs, Assistances on Small Loans, and other financial services in collaboration with the Nationalized Banks and other MFIs the details as follows

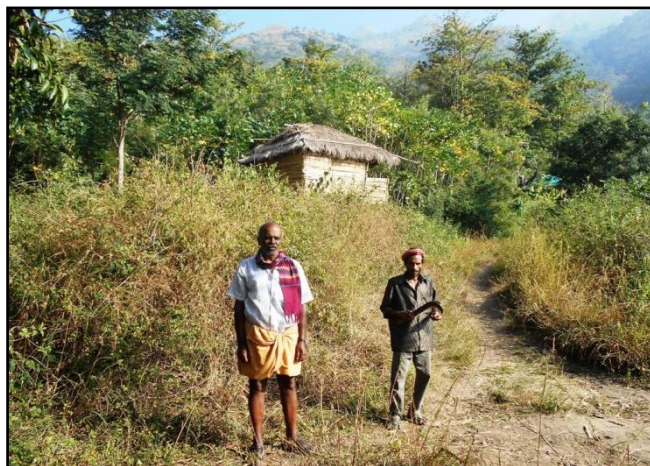

ENVIRONMENT & BIO-DIVERSITY Conservation

Awareness Workshop on Climate Change Workshop & Global Warming

As one of its essential theme, GREEN always takes serious efforts to propagate Environmental protection and Bio-diversity conservation in the working region. This year, we have conducted a special initiative on "Awareness Workshop on Climate Change matters and Global Warming issues. This program helps to reach the public in general, including Women SHG members, Students and Youths at a wider range to cover the awareness initiative on issues of Climate change matters, importance of Tree plantation, soil conservation practices, promotion of Rain water harvesting plans at household levels, need of local Environmental preservation and conservation of Bio diversity in the working region.



This program event was also created the debate forum among the SHG members, Students and Youth groups and the Farmers community in the working area.

Awareness Workshop on Organic Farming & Bio Manure preparation



This year GREEN had conducted a special Awareness workshop on the preparation of Bio manure at household level and promotion of Organic farming practices in to the farm fields in the working regions. This program facilitates, the Farmers and Youth club members come forward to organize the public events and making the arrangements on demonstration of Azola Cultivation, Organic Bio Fertilizer and Navakavya Preparation works. Further they have organized group level meetings in their living

locality and to motivate the members, public in general and others in their living villages on to address and Combat the Desertification, Land Degradation and Drought through collective efforts.

The Small & Marginal Farmers and the Women Farmers were actively engaged the program activities. As it is a different approach in their lands, especially the Agriculture / Farm lands contribute major role on promoting Organic Farming and raised how they can prevent and combat the soil erosion and preserve the Soil Fertility on their farm fields and its surrounding locality.

They are actively involving in Vermin compost demonstration. They promised to maintain soil fertility in their farm lands and do activities in their house hold level and will teach their children on the issue.

About 120 more small & marginal farmers and 100 women farmers and 85 Youth leaders at village level were understood their roles on prevent soil erosion techniques in their farm lands.

WOMEN RIGHTS AWARENESS - for Sumangali Victims Rehabilitation

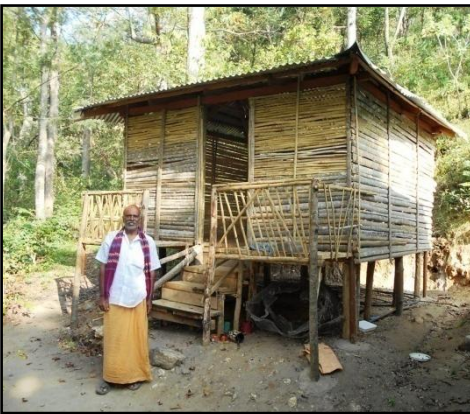
Through the assistance of local support groups, this year our GREEN conducted the special training on Legal Aid Awareness to the Sumangali Scheme Victims in our working area. This training facilitated them on Legal Support Services and Awareness on Women Rights Issues, violence against women, importance of girl child education, Adverse effects of Sumangali Schemes, Work spot violence against women especially the Adolescent girls,. Further this program promotes the awareness on Domestic violence against women and constitutional guarantees of women, and Law for prevention of women from under Domestic Violence Act 2005 etc., this program facilitates over 25 members on understanding the various issues related to women, domestic violence, negligence of girl children and guarantee measures to women. This program facilitates the Adolescent Girls and Women SHG leaders to come forward to understand their roles and participating in prevention of atrocities and violence against women.



GREEN – SELAVIP Project 2016

(Construction of BAMBOO Houses to Tribes in Kurangani Hills for Comfortable living and to Combat Climate change matters)

During the reporting year 2016, our GREEN has specially designed project namely **“Construction of 30 Bamboo Houses to Tribes in Kurangani Hills for Comfortable Living and to Combat Climate Change** was supported by **“SELAVIP Foundation”** in order to assure the safe and secured living to the Shelterless Tribes in the working area, GREEN has proposed to provide comfortable living places – the Shelters to the Tribes living in the Kurangani hill in the Western Ghats of India, located in Theni District. Further the aims focused that, to provide them low cost houses constructed with the help of bamboo and other locally available grass, lantana camara etc. under this project our GREEN had provided helps to construct Bamboo Houses to 30 poor indigenous tribes in Kurangani hilly areas and brief the community about biological diversity Acts and Rules, this project assure comfortable living and to meet the adversities of climate change.



Through the project impact, our GREEN Society made remarkable accomplishments of the Construction of Bamboo houses to Tribes for comfortable living and combat climate change under the eminent support of SELAVIP. And all the Tribal beneficiaries were supported by **Green Toilet** and **Solar Lamp Provisions** by our **GREEN Society** as a special and innovative effort.

TREAD Scheme 2015-2016

MSME, Govt of India & CANARA BANK (Follow up Activities)

Women are the vital component of the functioning of the community. They are the pivot of the society. GREEN believed this and continuing its service performances on the field of women development and welfare activities centered with women participants. For achieving its focused vision our GREEN has formed them in to women self help groups. During the year 2015 - 2016 we have supported them through a special TREAD (Trade Related Entrepreneur Development Program for Women Scheme) is supported by the Ministry of Micro Small & Medium Enterprises MSME, Govt of India for the development of rurally backward women in Chinnamanur Block and CANARA Bank – Erasakkanaiyakanur in Theni District is providing a Micro loan for each trades activity to the women self help group beneficiaries. This year 2016 – 2017, our GREEN made a follow-up activities of the TREAD Scheme, our Staff members were made a house visit to the beneficiaries, make interaction and providing necessary guidance and support services to the women to continue their business ventures and providing business counseling at their doorsteps. The women in this project have gained alternative and integrated opportunity to utilize their local base available resources in order to improve their financial status and for economically sustenance.

RURAL YOUTHS SKILLS DEVELOPMENT TRAININGS



In association with the Nehru Yuva Kendra (NYK), Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Govt of India, District Youth Coordinator, Theni Dist, TN and with the local Youth Club and neighboring working institution, that our organisation, our GREEN has conducted a 2 days camp activity for celebrating Youth empowerment Day to the youth in our working area. This camp was facilitated the youths on life skill orientation, group management, volunteering on social development activities,

Importance of involving Community development projects, family care and future goal etc. Over 30 youth volunteers from the neighboring organization and from the working area have attended the camp activities.



The resource team professionals and experts have offering the strategic discussion and brain storming sessions to the youth participants. Further this program discussed the current issues and problems faced by the Youths and finding solutions within them. This program enhanced youth volunteers to our organisation and encouraging youth's participation in community development. Our organisation has planned to conduct like this kinds of special events in the upcoming years.

AGRICULTURE & FARMERS DEVELOPMENT

Agriculture Women Development – Training Programs

Our GREEN society has given main agenda for working for promoting Sustainable Agriculture; we are concentrating the welfare of the Agriculture women and rural women working in Agriculture related activities. By this year, we are conducting a special Training program to the Agriculture Women on Sustainable Agriculture, Zero Budget Farming, Traditional Agriculture methods, Promotion of Organic Farming. This training facilitates about 35 Agriculture Women and rural women engaged in Agriculture related activities. We have also provided the Dry horti and Agro horticulture promotional trainings, which enhance the agriculture women on involving fruit bearing trees cultivation, bi-crops cultivation techniques, production of enriched bio manure preparation in their farm fields etc.,



GREEN had supported over 1500 agriculture women in the working area through facilitating Micro credit loan assistances to their agriculture related activities and providing Training, knowledge exposures and awareness events to the agriculture women for sustainable agriculture practices. Further we planned to conduct a comprehensive project for empowering Agriculture Women community in our working region by the upcoming years.

Meeting & Formation of FIG (Farmers Interested Group)



A new intervention committed by our GREEN society during this reporting year on facilitating the livelihood condition of the small and marginal farmers in our working area. Our GREEN Society have in collaboration with the District Horticultural Department - Theni on formation of the FIG (Farmers Interested Groups) and organize the small and middle farmers involving in Banana cultivation and other money yielding corps in their land.

We have formed over 55 Farmers Group on Banana Farming Category with 1100 farmers as members and about 25 among the Perumetro Vegetables Farming with 500 more farmers as regular members. The purpose of the program is to facilitate them on Training, Knowledge exposure and Technical assistances for retaining their cultivable lands and providing micro credit linkages and other related assistance for their agricultural sustenance of the FIG groups.



Small & Marginal Farmers Development Training Program



For facilitating the dry and waste lands into cultivable, our organization has organized a special training program to the farmers on “dry land agriculture promotion” by this year in the working village. In this program, over 76 farmers from the Small and Marginal Category were identified and they were encouraged to get involved in various horticultural processes, such as Dry horti and Agro horti activities. Further our organisation has extended support to provide Agriculture

Consultancy services, Soil Testing and knowledge exposure on Modern Agriculture Techniques to the Farmer beneficiaries under this training program.

Awareness on Small / Minor Millet Cultivation

GREEN Society has organised a training program to improve awareness and action to enhance the cultivation process of Small / Minor Millets. The Awareness Training facilitates the Small & Marginal Farmers group on to aware the Commercial value of Minor Millet and enable the farmers make his agriculture autonomous by cultivating Millets on increased hectares on their lands.



This training facilitates over 150 farmers, farmer women, agriculture cooli workers and women SHG members on to improve the agriculture on-farm diversity, providing fodder to livestock, improve the economic condition of the poor and un-privileged farmers communities and ensure food security, improve rural market of agriculture produces and make to sustain the small and marginal farmers in the working area.

SPECIAL DAYS OBSERVANTS – International Women’s Day

International Women’s Day was observed on March 2017 at Chinnamanur town which is center for our target area. The programme was organised with the coordination of local women Self-help Groups, other NGOs, Women activists and volunteers. The events are mainly focusing the empowerment of women community, raising voices on women development and making collective efforts on violence against women. The programme includes debates, role-plays, regarding women and development. Personals from the Tamilnadu Women Development Corporation, Banks, MFIs, and other Government Departments, neighboring organisation, women activists, and project partners had been honored as chief guest in this program. Totally about 850 women were participated and benefited the programme.



TRIBAL RIGHTS AWARENESS & DEVELOPMENT



Through the support of Simenpou Foundation and the Tamilnadu Adhivasi Fifth Schedule Campagin (TAFSC), our GREEN took an effort in promoting Tribal welfare in the working area located in Western Ghats. Our GREEN facilitated the Tribal youths on their Land Rights of their living locality as mentioned in the Vth Schedule and the way to protect their habitations/Land in Tribal village habitat. This campaign educates their rights on their living regimes and the minor / non-

timber forest produces for assuring their livelihoods and the Constitutional Guarantees under the “Forest Rights Act 2005” by organized a special program focusing to adapt the Fifth Schedule of the Constitution of India which protect and ensures the livelihoods of the Tribal Communities. Our organization believes that the adoption of the fifth schedule is the only way to empower tribal community and having this as motto, we have organized many continuous programs at Kurangani Tribal hamlets. Tribal Federation level activities promotes to increase the strength of the members, and to be conduct a movements based campaign activities for propagating the FRC Act, arranging infrastructure facilities and for distributing safe drinking water to all the tribal villages etc.,. The advantage of this federation is to announce prefixed price rates to the collectives (herbal, seeds, and other non-timber products) collected by the Tribal people and mainstreaming into social markets and assured income.

❁ Tree Plantation Program & Nursery Raising



This program facilitates the Tribal community on marketing their non-timber forest products directly without brokers and to aware on basic rights and promoting Tree plantation activities were promoted and so far we have planted over 2000 more trees in the targeted Tribal areas. We have also conducted the special Annual Convention on Tribal Rights and exploring awareness about the 5th Schedule which

ensure the Welfare and Rights of the Tribal. During this year an awareness program was organized at Kurangani village and a campaign program also organized.

❁ Low Carbon Farming Program

By this year, GREEN initiated a special campaign activity to create a awareness on promoting Low Carbon Farming initiatives in the working villages, this campaign facilitated the Tribal on practicing the “Low Carbon Farming” Activities; through the support of the TAFSC we have provided the “Solar Lamps” to about 150 pcs as covered more than 120 Tribal families living in the 10 tribal villages and tribal hamlets.



CHILDREN WELFARE SERVICES

❁ Children Campaign - TN Forces



Our GREEN society is always in concentration on participating the child welfare programs as they are the future generation and responsible to create a better society tomorrow. It believed that the Rights of the Children are also the Rights of the Human Rights. We have conducted a initiative on organizing the Child Parliament at each of the working villages that on promote the Children Rights to Participation and valuing them through a public level Campaign Activities. This Campaign activity mainly focuses the awareness creation

among the public in general about the Children Rights and Rights to participation, survival and development in the living society. This Campaign activity focuses to ensure the rights giving the policy level frame work by the current parliament election. It stresses the political parties through public advocacy on to put effect of the existing children rights and legal guarantees. GREEN vividly partake this campaign event through the support of TN-Forces and the neighboring organisation.

❁ Collaborative Initiatives on CHILD HELP LINE 1098

In association with the neighboring organisation, our GREEN has involving the CHILD HELP LINE Center activities at Theni District by the reporting year 2016. This Child Help Line Project Center activity are approved and recognized by the Dept of Social Defense, Govt of Tamilnadu through the support of Central Government. The main purpose of this CHILD HELP LINE 1098 Project is to extend care and support services to the children in harmful and risky situation. It provides counseling, care and emotional support to the children, providing immediate care to the Child Labours, Street children who are identified in the working area.



It is a 24 x 7 hrs dial up – Toll Free Telephone Number 1098 connectivity for receiving calls from any area of the district and our organisation will send the field staffs to extend the support services to the affected victim children in the district.

❁ Children Clubs (Boys & Girls)



In continuation of promoting Children based welfare initiatives our GREEN involved a special program initiative in association with the District Police Department, Theni Dist. Under this program, a “Boys & Girls Clubs” were organized in Chinnamanur Police Station which organize a group of Boys and Girls under the ages between 8yrs to 15 yrs in

the working villages into a Club. This Boys and Girls Club members were supported through various Sports related activities, Yoga & Meditation Classes, Soft skills promotion, Indoor – Outdoor Games, Recreation and Teaching of Motivation classes. The purpose of this Clubs is enhanced the friendly environment between the police personal with a social welfare perspective.

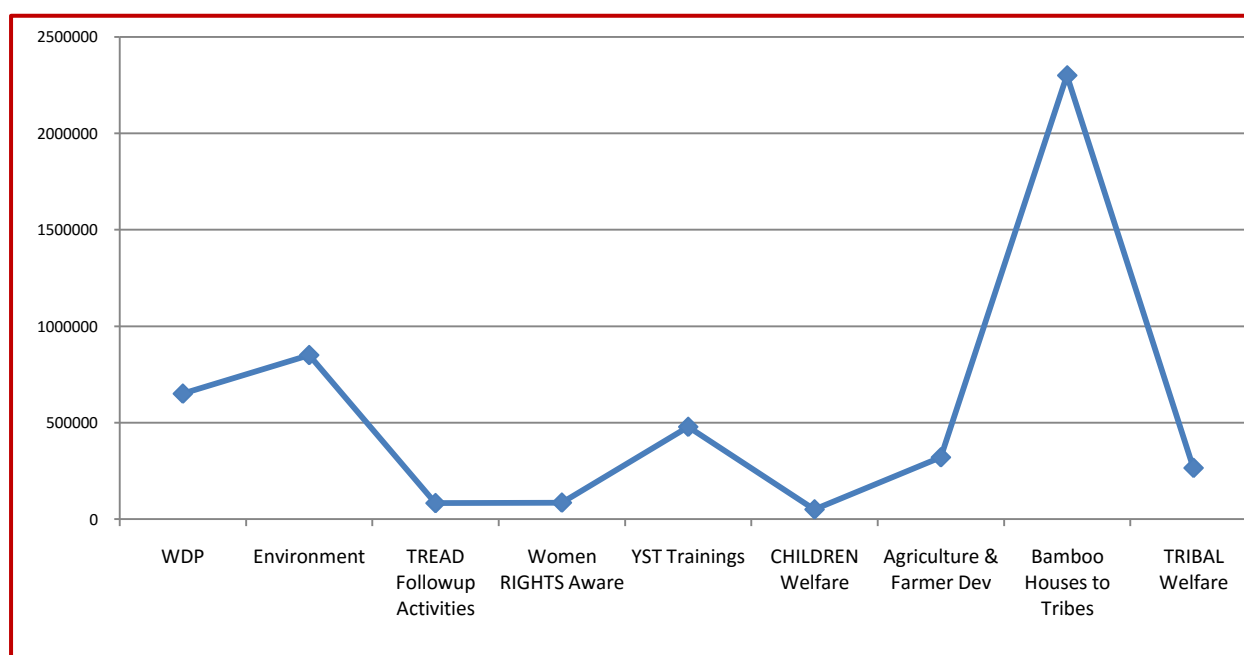


Through this clubs, The Sub Inspector of Police, Chinnamanur Police Station provided guest lectures on various functions of the police on maintaining Law & Order and how the public even children can help them. Further he give a session on Children Rights, Child Help Line 1098, how to approach a Police station for children related crimes etc., GREEN organized a Resource persons to conduct various events of this Boys & Girls Clubs and for its maintenance activities.
